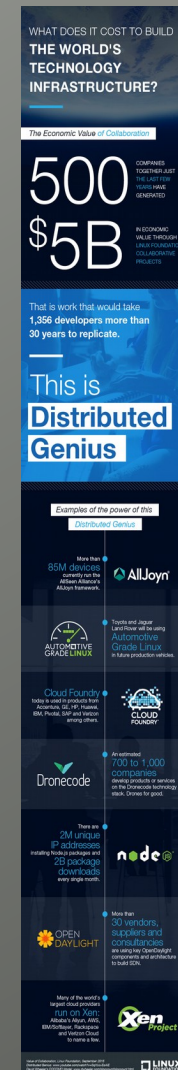

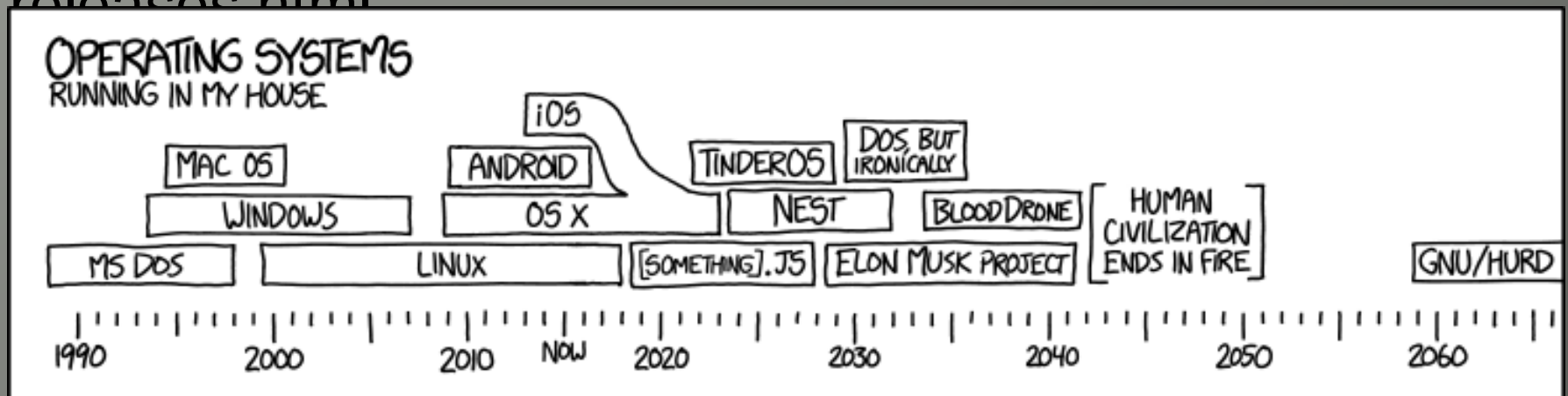
Parabola first FSF approved Distro to Support ARM
